## Information on the installation, maintenance and usage of Horizons item HOZ2582 with "glitter"

## Installation:

- Before installing, please inspect the tiles for shade variations, surface quality, and any visible imperfections.
- This product is only suitable for walls.
- This product should only be installed with grout joints
- Only use un-sanded grout for this product. Do not use an epoxy grout.
- Please follow all grout manufacturers' instructions for grouting.
- Please use similar color grouts to the tile as strong colored grouts may affect the shade of the design surface.
- The surface of Horizons decorative tile is produced with a "glitter". Whenever possible, while grouting, we recommend avoiding the parts covered with "glitter", to avoid excessive rubbing-off of the "glitter".
- In the process of cleaning the grout, some of the "glitter" may come off and the tile may lose some of its shine.

## **Usage and Maintenance:**

- Please only use light detergents for cleaning (water with light soap, and neutral cleaners etc.)
- Do not use abrasive cleaning agents and products containing chloride or other bleaches.
- Do not use pastes or "cleaning milks" (they contain abrasive cleaning powders, which may lead to the removal of the "glitter").
- Please use a soft microfiber cloth, a soft sponge (spongy cloth) or chamois leather for cleaning.
- Do not scrub. Do not use any brushes, rough sponges or rough cloths.
- In different angles and lighting, changes in the brilliance and intensity of the shine are the nature of this product.

Damages arising from lack of inspection improper installation, use of improper cleaning products, mortars and grouts are not subject to claims and any applicable warranties will be voided.

**CAUTION: TILE CONTAINS SILICA**. Silica dust is harmful if inhaled. Exposure to silica dust from cutting, grinding, or polishing product can cause acute lung injury or cancer. Wet cutting methods are recommended. Use adequate dust prevention methods, including but not limited to: masks, protective goggles, and gloves. Children should not be present during installation process.
